What is the Volunteer of the Year Award?

The RRDSB **Volunteer of the Year Award** is a way to celebrate the important contributions of volunteers toward student success in Board schools. This contribution of time and talent by special community volunteers provides additional attention for our students and strengthens our partnership with the surrounding community.

Who is eligible?

All individual, group, or volunteer organizations whose volunteer activities benefit students in Board schools in a substantial, important or unique way.

Who is not eligible?

- Persons nominating themselves, spouses or family members
- Persons who received compensation for services provided
- Board employees

General Information for Submitting a Nomination

- *Nomination Application Forms* may be duplicated. Please submit a separate *Nomination Application Form*.
- Complete and send a brief contribution summary (no more than 200 words) in the *Nomination Application Form*. This is an important part of the nomination application process. It is suggested that the following is included:
 - a) an overview of the type of volunteer activity
 - b) the need(s) that the volunteer activity addressed
 - c) any special achievements or unusual challenges overcome
 - d) any innovations utilized
 - e) length of service
- A committee of Board trustees will make the selection based on submissions. The winner of the **Volunteer of the Year Award** will receive this award during the Employee Recognition Night at La Place Rendez-vous on **June 16th, 2006**.
