**POLICY**

The Rainy River District School Board will support educational research that enhances student achievement and well-being.

**RATIONALE**

Education research informs decision-making around programs, policies, and practices, ultimately supporting improved outcomes for all learners.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

As per Procedure 2.69, Research Requests

**GUIDELINES**

- 1.1 The Rainy River District School Board recognizes the need to ensure that research conducted within its schools meets the Tri-Council Policy Statement: Ethical Conduct for Research Involving Humans (TCPS2) and beneficial to education in general and to the Board in particular.
- 1.2 The Board believes that there is a need to balance the potential benefits of educational research with the needs of the school(s). Research requests will be considered based on the proposed research’s impact on schools, and the system. All research requests shall be submitted to the Director of Education/designate.
- 1.3 The Board of Trustees will be informed of all approved research projects.
- 1.4 Confidentiality is an important aspect of research conducted in the Rainy River District School Board. All personal and confidential information must be administered in accordance with the *Municipal Freedom of Information and Protection of Privacy Act and its Regulations*.

Definitions:

The term “research” does not refer to the necessary data collection required by schools and the system, as well as the Ministry of Education, and excludes internal research related to Rainy River District School Board programming.
