- 1.1 Staff may attend professional development activities, subject to
 - the approved professional development budget,
 - the availability of replacement staff,
 - the discretion of the Director or designate.
- 1.2 Approvals for staff members to attend a meeting, workshop, conference, seminar, or training are granted by the Director of Education or designate.
- 1.3 If the professional development is:
 - of direct benefit to the Board, the Board will pay appropriate expenses.
 - of direct benefit to the staff member and indirect benefit to the Board or students, the Board may share appropriate expenses with the staff member.
 - of benefit to the staff member and the Federation/Union or other agency, full costs are the responsibility of the staff member, Federation/Union or other agency
