POLICY

The Rainy River District School Board will set the level of honoraria for the trustees within the limits set by provincial regulation.

RATIONALE

The Rainy River District School Board recognizes the importance and value of providing fair levels of honoraria for its members as set out in Ontario Regulation 357/06.

IMPLEMENTATION

In accordance with the *Education Act*, Regulation 357/06.

GUIDELINES

- 1.1 The Rainy River District School Board shall establish the honorarium based on the following components, as the Board determines, subject to Ontario Regulation 357/06 s.4:
 - i) the base amount;
 - ii) the enrolment amount;
 - iii) the attendance amount for trustees attending meetings;
 - iv) the distance amount for travel to and from meetings of the Board.
- 1.2 The Honoraria is established as follows:

1.3 Honoraria will be prorated for less than a full year served.

- 1.4 A Student Trustee receives \$2,500 per year of their term.
- 1.5 This policy is in effect for the Board of as described within the *Education Act* or its Regulations.

Definitions:

Enrolment Amount – The Board's average daily enrolment number for the Board's fiscal year that ends in the calendar year in which the year of the term of office commences.

Term - A member's term begins on November 15 and ends on the following November 14.
