SECTION 4

EXTRA-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

Students

POLICY

The Rainy River District School Board will support the provision of extra-curricular activities.

RATIONALE

Extra-curricular activities enhance students' talents, abilities, and special interests. These experiences foster self-esteem, leadership, and social skills.

IMPLEMENTATION

As per the guidelines below and Policy and Procedure 5.10, Field Trips, Policy and Procedure 8.24 Fundraising, and Policy 7.85 Student Safety

GUIDELINES

1.0 General Guidelines

- 1.1 The principal is responsible for annually approving the purposes and goals of an extracurricular activity in terms of:
 - the appropriateness to the age, and physical and intellectual maturity of the students involved;
 - the skills of staff and/or community members;
 - the needs of students;
 - student safety;
 - human resources, including the availability of other necessary resources.
- 1.2 All extra-curricular activities will be conducted in a manner that maintains or enhances the dignity and self-esteem of the individual student.
- 1.3 The staff supervisor is responsible for ensuring the safety of all participants. Students and their parents/guardians will be made aware of all procedures and guidelines as outlined in related Board policies and procedures.
- 1.4 Sports and athletic activities will be governed by the relevant District, regional, and provincial athletic organizations.
- 1.5 The approval, planning, and safety requirements for extra-curricular overnight and extended trips will be as per the Policy and Procedure 5.10, Field Trips.
- 1.6 As extra-curricular activities are optional, students may be responsible for costs associated

with participation.

2.0 Eligibility

- 2.1 Participation in an extra-curricular activity will be non-discriminatory.
- 2.2 Student participation in extra-curricular activities is subject to
 - Adherence to the School and Board Code of Conduct
 - Academic progress
 - Regular school attendance
- 2.3 All students participating in extra-curricular activities shall abide by the School and Board Code of Conduct.
- 2.4 It is expected that participants will attend practices, meetings, or rehearsals, follow the directions of the staff supervisor and other volunteers, and display a positive and respectful attitude. Students may become ineligible if they do not meet their obligations to their team, club or group.

Definition:

Extra-curricular Activity is an activity performed by students that falls outside the realm of the normal curriculum of school and enhances a student's school experience. This activity may be participative or competitive (i.e., sports, clubs, theatre productions).
