<b>SAFE DRINKING WATER SYSTEMS</b>	<b>7.81</b>

**POLICY**

The Rainy River District School Board shall provide safe drinking water at all Board facilities.

**RATIONALE**

The Board is committed to providing safe drinking water to support the health and safety of all members of the school community.

**IMPLEMENTATION**

As per Procedure 7.81 Drinking Water Systems and Procedure 7.82 Drinking Water Fixture Lead Testing and Flushing.

**GUIDELINES**

- 1.1 All water provided by the drinking-water system shall meet prescribed drinking-water quality standards.
- 1.2 The drinking-water system shall be staffed, supervised and operated in accordance with the applicable legislation.
- 1.3 All sampling, testing and monitoring requirements shall be in compliance with applicable legislation including the prompt reporting of adverse water conditions.
