








Site Plan Construction Zone








Construction Auto Shop 2nd Semester



Construction Oversight

- Project is very well defined by a package of 215 drawings.
- A 640-page specification booklet supports these drawings.
- Before materials are purchased, a shop drawings is submitted to the consultant team to ensure it meets specifications.
- If something is not clear or understood, there is a process defined in our contract documents to sort it out.
- The designers will make 72 site visits to monitor the progress of construction and identify any errors or deficiencies in construction.

Construction Oversight – Cont'd

- RRDSB staff will also be on site to monitor progress and help problem solve any issues.
- Construction meetings occur every two weeks.
- In the past 8 years, the RRDSB has successfully completed approximately \$19M of renovations, additions and site improvements at various facilities. All these elements are included in this project as well.
- Schedule is hard to control however.

Communication

 As things change, we will send letters home to notify parents/guardians of changes.

- There will be signage posted to keep building occupants aware of construction zones.

Looking Ahead - 2021-22 School Year

- Multi use technology lab will be completed for school programming.
