Update on Elementary Progress Reports

Following last week's ratified tentative settlement reached between the Government and ETFO Teachers, we have some updates to share with parents about Elementary Progress Reports.

The Central Tentative Agreement outlines that elementary teachers will complete progress reports for students in Grades 1 to 8. Teachers will be completing progress reports and distributing them on Monday, December 7, 2015. Along with other school boards across the province, Progress Reports for Early Years/Kindergarten will not be completed. As always, all parents are invited and encouraged to contact their child's teacher to discuss their child's progress. Our educators have an ongoing commitment to student well-being and success, and will continue to directly contact parents if there are any concerns regarding their student's progress.

As part of the Central Tentative Agreement teacher-parent interviews remain at the discretion of the teacher and will be initiated if the teacher has a concern about a student's progress. With the approaching holiday season, we recognize that there may be additional opportunities for parents to visit our classrooms and schools, and we welcome such participation and visits.

Positive outreach to parents remains a key priority for the Board to ensure students have a successful school year.
